







Penn Carey Law's Asian Pacific American Law Students Association (APALSA), Middle Eastern Law Student Association (MELSA), Muslim Law Students Association (MLSA), and South Asian Law Student Association (SALSA) stand united with the Black Law Students Association (BLSA) and its statement on Professor Amy Wax. The recent sanctions against her, though a necessary first step, provide only temporary recourse for future students of color and no protection for current students in our communities.

We call for the University to take stronger action against and terminate Wax, who has openly stated that "the United States is better off with fewer Asians and less Asian immigration." We call for the immediate cancellations of the guest visits from Jared Taylor and future white supremacists to campus. We call for an environment that is free of racism, discrimination, and bigotry, starting not tomorrow but today.
